Thursday, August 20

Join us as we board our flight from Minneapolis to Anchorage to begin our Alaska Fishing Adventure.

Upon arrival to Anchorage, a Riley motorcoach will meet us to bring us for our drive to Kenai Riverbend Resort, located on the banks of the World Famous Kenai River in Soldotna, Alaska. This area is truly an anglers paradise and a fishing experience of a lifetime.



Friday and Saturday, August 21 & 22

The first two days of our adventure will be spent fishing for River Silver Salmon. These bright Silvers or Coho salmon average 10-20 pounds and when the action is hot expect boat limits within hours. The take down of the silver is by far the most exciting part of the battle and at times you will see your line going upstream before you know the fish is on. Silver fishing is fun and relaxing and catching is fast and furious.



Sunday, August 23

The Cook Inlet is fast becoming the finest Halibut Fishing in the World. The fast and safe 28'-33' boats with experienced crews will lead you to prime halibut grounds. On the average the halibut range from 25-80 pounds, but can be as large as 200-300 pounds. With a two fish limit, you will take home more than enough for a few meals and gifts for your friends. Not enough can be said for this rich fishery except AWESOME!



Monday, August 24

Seward is a fishing paradise and fast becoming a favorite. Today you will have the opportunity to fish for Silver Salmon, Ling Cod, and Rockfish. Imagine every angler on the boat with fish on and lines going everywhere. Exciting and exhilarating!



Tuesday, August 25

We depart our great fishing adventure with our catch packed for shipping home; and our exciting fishing tales spinning in our minds as we board the coach for the trip to Anchorage to meet our flight home.



Summers are beautiful with a typical day beginning with morning temperatures in the 40's and daytime highs getting up to high 70's. Rain and clouds are possible at anytime but usually do not last long. There are not many insects.

From May to the end of August there is an average of 19 hours a day of sunlight, rising at 4:00 a.m. and setting at 11:00 p.m. Allowing plenty of time and daylight to do all the things you want while on your fishing vacation!

Pack light! Dress is very informal in Alaska. You could wear the same jeans and shirt for a week and nobody would look at you differently. We recommend jeans, sweatshirts, tennis shoes and knee-high boots and rain gear. For your comfort, dressing in layers is the way to travel.
